

POSITION: **Community Living Support Worker**
STATUS: **Casual**



DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

The primary function of this position is to provide meaningful, personalized support for individuals in their home and community. Successful applicants will be physically capable of performing safe transferring techniques and participating in all aspects of recreation and leisure activities (i.e. swimming). All other duties and responsibilities are outlined in the job description for the Community Living Support Worker.

QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE:

The successful applicant should have post-secondary education and must have experience working with individuals with developmental/physical disabilities. Applicants must be able to demonstrate an understanding and commitment to the philosophy of Community Living. Applicants must possess or be willing to obtain a Class 4 BC Driver's License. Must also meet all other CSCL employment requirements (eg. Criminal Record Check, Doctor's Certificate of Good Health, First Aid/CPR, Caring About Food Safety/FoodSafe etc.).

HOURS OF WORK:

Casual, On Call.

Shift work, must be available evenings and weekends with the possibility of leading to part-time or full-time positions. Must be available to work at least 3 shifts a week.
