- Must be physically able to meet the demands of the job.
- A positive and pleasant work attitude, effective communication skills and a solid understanding of consistent work practices are essential.
- This position will require continued training and working closely with external professionals.
- Experience with mental health will be an asset.
- Must possess a Class 5 Driver's License, First Aid/CPR Certification, Caring About Food Safety, and be able to meet all other CSCL employment criteria (i.e. Criminal Record Check clearance, Doctor's Certificate of Good Health, etc.)
