Why you should work for CSCL:

- Wage: \$20.52 - \$23.90 per hour
- This position requires Union membership (BCGEU).
- Part time positions may lead to Full Time positions (which include benefits such as Extended Health and Dental as well as participation in the Municipal Pension Plan, when eligible.)
- Recipient of the Canadian Non Profit Employer of Choice Award (neoc.ca) in 2017, 2018, 2019

What you'll do as the Community Living Support Worker:

- The primary function of this position is to provide meaningful, personalized support for individuals in their home and community.
- Perform safe transferring techniques and participate in all aspects of recreation and leisure activities (e.g. swimming).
- Promote and support Individual rights and facilitate meaningful community inclusion.
- Facilitate ongoing learning opportunities for personal growth and development of the individual.
- Facilitate opportunities for the development of personal relationships.
- Contribute to the development and implementation of personalized plans.
- Promote Positive Behaviour Supports and effective communication.

Qualifications:

- Experience in supporting individuals with varying degrees of developmental disabilities.
- Able to demonstrate knowledge of current issues and practices, human values in delivery of service, and a strong ability to plan and work independently while actively involving individuals in this process.
- A positive and pleasant work attitude, effective communication skills and the ability to relate positively to the public.
- Must be physically able to perform all lifting/transferring duties and participate in regular program activities (i.e. swimming).
- Must possess a valid BC Class 4 Driver's License and willing to obtain First Aid/CPR Certification.
- Due to the nature of this schedule, applicants must be flexible and available for all day, afternoon, and weekend shifts. Weekend availability is mandatory (see more details below)

Schedule:

Shifts will vary to meet the requirements of the service; schedule flexibility is required. **This is a "float" style position to cover shorts from vacation and leave requests. Minimum 24 hours per week, posted 2 weeks ahead as per collective.**

The hours in this position may be worked over a 7-day work week consistent with Article 14.1 – Definitions. This position is guaranteed a minimum of 24 hours per week with the possibility of working up to 40 hours per week at straight-time.

****This is a temporary position** to cover a Leave vacancy until March 2021, with a possibility of an extension for an additional 6 to 12 month depending on program needs.
